FISHERIES ACT, 2020 (No. 40 of 2020)

FISHERIES RESOURCES (JURISDICTION AND CONSERVATION)(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2022

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred by section 126 of Fisheries Act (No. 40 of 2020) hereby makes the following regulations —

1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) These Regulations, which amends the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation) Regulations¹, may be cited as the Fisheries Resources (Jurisdiction and Conservation)(Amendment) Regulations, 2022.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 2022.

2. Amendment of regulation 28 of the principal Regulations.

Regulation 28 of the principal Regulations is amended —

- (a) in paragraph (1), by the deletion of the word "and" and the substitution of the word "any"; and
- (b) by the deletion of paragraph (2) and the substitution of the following
 - "(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) shall apply to any person leaving The Bahamas with a quantity of conch not exceeding fifty pounds in weight carried in his personal baggage for any purpose that is not commercial.".

3. Repeal and replacement of Second Schedule to the principal Regulations.

The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is repealed and replaced as follows—
